#### SUBMIT YOUR SCORE TO THE RUFFSCORE RECORD BOOK

Both Typical and Non-Typical scoring deducts differences between normal right and left side points. Symmetry = a higher score.

Left side of card has boxes for Left and Right side measurments.

Right side is for Net Score. Enter L+R Total or smaller x 2 as shown.

Entering 2x smaller measurement is a quicker way to the Net Score.

- TP Count Normal (Typical) and Abnormal points starting with the Brow Tine or Eye Guard. Main Beam is the last point.
- AP Abnormal Points (or any point) must be one inch long to count.
  - Choose only one Typical or Non-Typical. Subtract or Add Total.
- NP Measure from top of beam to tip. Add length of all Normal Points on the side together and enter the total.
  - Main Beam (the last point) is not measured for point length.
- MB Main Beam length is along the outer edge from Burr to tip.
- CB "Official" scoring measures four circumferences on each side.
  - A piece of string is best way to get a quick total for all four.

    Add all 4 of these measurements: between Burr and Point 1, Point 1

    and Point 2, Main Beam and Point 3, Point 2 and Point 4.
- Is Inside Spread has to be at a right angle to the skull center line.
  Cannot be diagonal. Length is limited to longest Main Beam.
